Video capsule endoscopy is a minimally invasive procedure to identify surface lesions in the stomach and intestines. It can be utilised in patients with gastrointestinal signs or bleeding or monitoring of patients with already diagnosed gastrointestinal disorders.

All we have to do is administer the capsule.

All we have to do is administer the capsule No general anaesthesia required!

It is a generally well-tolerated procedure and is indicated in those patients who cannot have general anaesthesia for traditional flexible endoscopy or in cases who need follow up endoscopic visualization to monitor for lesion progression after traditional endoscopy has been performed.

In one study there were no adverse effects or complications except for 2 dogs who had retention of the capsule in the stomach.
